

Buggy and Disability Policy

Bristol And District Lady Golfers' Alliance

These will vary as each golfer will have unique requirements, but the basis is the same:

That each golfer has access to the game at the level of her ability

if she qualifies for the Alliance team in her club, then she should be enabled to play with support.

Use of Buggies in Bristol and District Alliance Lady Golfers' Matches:

Buggies may be used in Alliance matches if a player is not able to walk due to a long term medical condition or is awaiting/recovering from hip or knee operations on the proviso that buggies are permitted by the host club, and they deem it safe to use on the day of the match.

The team captain of the person needing to use a buggy should inform the opposing team captain prior to the match who should arrange for the buggy to be provided at members' rates wherever possible.
